 also I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my loving wife Eliza Beale my
 whole & sole executrix to this my last will & testament with full power & authority to sell
 any part of my personal estate either at private or publick sale as she shall
 think best for the payment of my debts and also with full power to emancipate
 & set free any slave or slaves which now are or hereafter may becom or appertain to my
 estate And I do hereby revoke & annul all other wills by me heretofore made ra-
 tifying and confirming this & no other to be my last will & testament In witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 16th day of February Anno Domini 1796.
