

At a court held for the county of Southampton the 18th day of October 1790 This will was presented in court by John Gwatney the coor^r therein named, proved by the oaths of James Dicks Daniel Davis and Herbert Hodge three of the witnesses thereto and read to the court and on the motion of the s^d executor who made oath according to law a certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form The testator by this will directing that his exec^s shall not be obliged to give security

In the Name of God amen the 19th day of January Anno Dom. 1793 I, William Hallaman of the County of Southampton and Parish of Nettleway being sick of body but in perfect sense and sound mind and Memory thanks be to almighty God calling to mind the mortality of my body knowing that it is appointed for all men to die do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following (to wit).

I give to my son John Hallaman one certain track or parcel of land lying on the East side of the main road containing by estimation nighly acres be the same more or less beginning at the seven pines thence along a line dividing the s^d land & Joseph Harbts land to William Baileys line thence along the said Baileys line to a corner in Barbacue branch thence down the said branch to a mouth of a small branch thence up the small branch to the head thence a long a line of marked trees to the main road thence along the road to the beginning to him and his heirs for ever and one Negro called Jane to him and his heirs for ever and like wise one feather bed and furniture to him & his heirs for ever.

Item

I give to my son William Hallaman one certain track or parcel of land lying on the East side of the main road containing by estimation singly acres more or less beginning at the main road at the head of a bottom thence along line of marked trees to the head of a small branch thence down the branch to Barbacue branch thence down Barbacue branch to the mouth of a small branch joining Nicajah Hallamans land thence up the said small branch to the head thence along a line of marked trees to the main road thence along the road to the beginning to him and his heirs for ever and one Negro called Simon to him and his heirs for ever like wise one bed and Furniture to him & his heirs forever.
