Then I lend the use of the remainder of my lands to my loving wife during her natural life and after her death I give the above said remainder of my lands to my Son Thomas Hallamman to him & his heirs for ever.
Then I lend the use of all the rest of my estate to be it of what nature or kind soever to my loving Lucy Hallamman for & during her natural life for the benefit of raising & maintaining my children and after her death to be equally divided between my three sons viz John William Thomas or the survivors of them to them & their heirs for ever.

lastly I constitute and appoint my wife Lucy Hallamman & my two sons John & William my whole & sole Exors. of this my last will & testament revoking and making void all and every other will heretofore by me made in witness where of I have herunto set my hand & affixed my seal the date and year first above written.
