(nam'd) Dagles and Cury Children of Penny to him and his heirs forever
- Item I Give and bequeath to Allen Deloach Durn two negroes (nam'd) Harry & Venus to
him and to his heirs forever
- Item I Give & bequeath to Thomas Deloach Durn two Negroes (namely) Sam & Beck to
him and his heirs forever
- Item I Give & bequeath to Williamson Parker two Negroes namely Jacob & David to
him and his heirs forever
- Item I Give & bequeath to Frederick Parker son of Drews Parker dec^d all and every
part of my Estate not heretofore given away to him and his heirs forever
And I do also appoint Col^l Sam^l Wells all and the whole Executor to this
my last Will revoking and annulling by these presents all former Wills by me made
declaring this to be my last will and Testament and none other In Witness where
of I have hereunto set my hand and fixed my seal this fourteenth day
of November in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety six
