whereon I now live to her and her heirs forever - also one feather bed
and furniture and her share of two Cows and earlings -

Item 4th I give and to my daughter Hannah Simmons one negroe girl named
Cherry at the value of thirty pounds which sum is to be deducted from
a division of my negroes hereafter mentioned One feather bed and furniture
to her and her heirs forever -

Item 5th I give and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Drury my
negroe girl Liza at the value of thirty pounds which is to be deducted
from a division of my negroes hereafter mentioned also one feather
bed and furniture to her and her heirs forever -

Item 6th Remainder of my estate to be sold by my executors and the money
arising therefrom to be divided in the following manner -
To my daughter Hannah Simmons (deducting the thirty pounds before
mentioned) One third to her and her heirs forever -
To my daughter Elizabeth Drury one third deducting the thirty pounds
before mentioned to her and her heirs forever -

Item 7th I give and bequeath to my daughter Rhoady Andrews children
The remaining one third provided she has child or children that
arrives to the age of twenty one years if not the said one third
to be divided between my two daughters Hannah & Elizabeth
