Item My will is that after my Just debts & funeral expenses is paid if any ready Money for it be equally divided between the above mentioned Grand Children & Great grand Child —

Item I do nominate and appoint Edmund Turner my sole & sole Executor to this my last Will & Testament, My Witnesses whom I have hereunto set my hand this thirty first day of October One Thousand Seven hundred & Ninety four
