In the name of God Amen I Lighthorn Lowe of the county of Southampton and parish Mottray being sick and weak in body but of sound mind and memory do make and explain this to be my last will and Testament in manner and form as followeth (Viz)

- Item I Give unto my five sons namely, Jeremiah, Samuel, Cayah, Willis, and Wiley Lowe all my land and plantations whome I now live to be equally Divided between my five sons above named but it is my will and desire that my two eldest sons Jeremiah Lowe, Samuel Lowe and my Daughter Milly Lowe should have the use of the whole of my Land and plantations for the term of ten years and after the term of time to be equally Divided as above mentioned
- Item I Give unto my Daughter Milly Lowe 60 pounds cash extraordinary to be raised out of my Estate or one feather bed and furniture which she may choose of to her and her heirs forever
- Item I Give unto my Daughter Patsy Lowe six pounds cash or one bed and furniture which she may make choice of to her and her heirs forever
- Item It is my will and desire that there should be as much cash raised
