 weak in body but of perfect mind and Memory thanks be to God for it, do make and
 make this my last Will and Testament and as touching such worldly estate which is
 in his power Give to his wife in this life I give in the following manner
 I give to my son John Maget all the Negroes and their Increase and every other article which
 I have heretofore put in his possession also what he is entitled to me to him & his heirs
 forever
 I give and devise to my son James Maget the Land purchased of William Bogan
 and all the Negroes and their Increase and every other article which I have heretofore put
 in his possession to him and his heirs forever
 I give and devise to my son Samuel Maget the plantation whereon I now live with three
 hundred and Twenty acres of Land more or less joining thereto bounded by John
 Whitehairs the said Samuel Maget's share and a line of Marked Trees from the said
 Samuels house near a southeast corner to the Cypress Swamp and down the Run
 of the said Cypress swamp to the Cabin Swamp and up the said Cabin Swamp
 to the Beginning and all the Negroes and their Increase and every other article which
 I have heretofore put in his possession also one third of my cattle to him and his heirs forever
