& in a low state of Health bit of some time & memory as make this my last Will &
Testament in maner & form following (To wit) First & principally I give my
soul to Almighty God the Creator of that & all things, & as for my worldly Goods
as Followeth

I give & bequeath to my Brother William Iverson Westbrooke, Three Negroes Namely
Sam Charles, & Nancy, one Walnut Desk, a large looking Glass, which said Negroes,
Desk and Glass I give to him & his heirs forever

I give & bequeath to my Nephew Nathaniel Westbrooke my Riding Harness To him & his heirs
for ever.

I give & bequeath to my Brother William P. Westbrooke all the Remainder of my Estate
of what kind or Nature soever a whole & severall parts to him & his heirs forever -
and fully constituted I appoint my Brother William Iverson Westbrooke my heir
& sole Executor to this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking all other Wills
by me heretofore made In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal
this Third day of October 1779 Three
