WILL

In the Name of God Amen. I Bewant Crumpler of the  
parish of Hillesway and County Southampton, being sick and weak in my last  
a perfect sound mind and memory make and remise this my last will and Testa-  
ment. In manner and form as follows viz & - - - -

Item. I give unto my son William Crumpler five Shillings -

Item. I give unto Alice Johnson one Shilling Sterling -

Item. I give unto my son Bewant Crumpler my Farm and plantation wherein I now  
live containing one hundred acres be the the same more or less. Also one New bed-  
bed of furniture one falling Table, one large pine Chest, one Apple-mill together  
with all the necessaries I have for raising fruit. All my kitchen Tools, one half  
Calf cut into one half of a Hind-stay. Two hens, Two Pigs, and the increase  
thereof, one young Cow & Yearling, one black heifer, and the increase thereof.  
One barrel mare, New-hamle & bridle. Two guns, one Cart & wheels, one plough from  
Upminster Green, Two Suges, Two bushels one hand mill, one Morrow Ax, one Gun  
Chest, One plough three one reaving, One grubing, One fine Pewter Jug, one  
half gallon water Jug, pair Bon wings, three Chairs, 32d Bottles, one Glass half  
pint bottle. All these to him and his heirs forever -

Item. I give unto Ann Little five Shillings -

Item. I give unto Elly Johnson five Shillings -

Item. I bind unconditionally Sarah Crumpler all the remains of my estate not  
above mentioned During her life or widowhood and at her death or marriage  
it is my will and desire that it should be equally divided between my  
three daughters Namely, Molly, Anna, Betsy Crumpler & Sally  
Crumpler to them and their heirs forever -

And Lastly I do appoint my son Bewant Crumpler and my friend Jas.  
Crumpler to be my whole and sole Executors of this my last Will and Tes-  
tament making void all other will by me heretofore made. I the  
Witness my hand Seal this 1<sup>st</sup> Day of October 1795 -
