In the Name of God Amen I Thomas Crumpley of
Southampton County do make and declare this my last Will and Testament
in manner and form as follows (Viz)
First I give to my Wife Susannah Crumpley the use of the plantation
whereon I now live with all the Land thereunto belonging during her
natural life, after her decease, I give the said Land to my Son William
Crumpley to him and his heirs forever but also give to my Son William
Crumpley my Cooper's tools, also my Gun
Second, I give to my Wife Susannah the use of all the Remainder of my Estate
every kind after the payment of my just Debts during her natural life, but
she have Liberty to make use & dispose of any part thereof as may appear
necessary for her support and after her Decease to be Equally divided
between my three Children (To wit) William, Martha, & Eria Crumpley and
bequeathed one Feather Bed & Furniture I give to my Daughter Eria, &c.
Lastly, I do appoint my Wife Susannah and my son William Crumpley
Executors to this my last Will & Testament In WITNESS whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this the 16th Day of September
1796
