I give to my mother in law Elizabeth Jones during her natural life
the following Negroes (Viz^t) Sam, Mungoe, Ephraim, Coleman, Osban
Milly, Jane, Meriah, Willis, and Ellen also three hundred pounds
if there be as much estate left which I got by my dec^d husband
Charles B Jones after paying all his just debts and after the death
of the said Elizabeth Jones my desire is that the negroes and their
increase together with the said three hundred pounds be Equally
