 Item I give to my Daughter Nancy Butts the Sum of Seventy five pounds Current Money of Virginia to her and her heirs for ever—
 Item I give the remainance of my Estate if there be any to be equally divided amongst my four Children namely Benj^a Butts Robert Butts Nancy Butts & Polly Nicholson to them and their heirs for ever—
 Lastly I do nominate my friends Zebulon Lewis & Benjamin Lewis my Executors to this my last Will and Testament—
