Also - I give devise and bequeath to Shadrach Cobb for his favouring my by
pin & Table —

Also - I give devise and bequeath to Joshua Seymour of Texas all the remainder
of my Estate consisting of nine head of hogs with every thing hereafter
not mentioned in the other Legacies and I do hereby revoke & annul all
other wills by me heretofore made ratifying and confirming this and no
