In the name of God Amen I Simon Vicks of Southampton County and State of Virginia being in a low state of health but in perfect sense and memory do make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form as followeth Testimoney -

Item - Gives and bequeath to Adams March Marshall five Shillings to him and his heirs forever —

Item - Gives and bequeath to my grand Daughter Mason Vick one Negroe namely Siny to her and her heirs forever —

Item - Gives and bequeath to my grand Son Little Buary Vick one Negroe namely Dinky to him and his heirs forever —

Item - Gives and bequeath to my grand son John Vick one negro namely

Rosie to him and his heirs forever —

Item - Gives and bequeath to my grand Daughter Lucy Vick one Negroe

namely Petie to her and her heirs forever —

Item - Gives and bequeath to my grand son Peterson Vick one negro namely Venus to him

and his heirs forever —

Item - My Will and desire is that all the rest and remainder of my Estate be sold and after my just Debts paid the money arising from such sale to be equally Divided between my Sons Jacob

Vick, Jesse Vick, & John Vick —

I do also constitute and appoint my son Jacob Vick my sole and sole Executor to his my last Will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affix my seal this 26<sup>th</sup> day of Sept 1798

Further I give her a Beding Chair & Kearngs one Bay Horse, one Bay Mare and Two Trotters Beds and Furniture —
