In the name of God Amen. I Simon Vick of Southampton County and State of Virginia being in a low state of health but in Perfect Sense and memory do make this my last Will and Testament in Manner and form as followeth To wit: I give and bequeath to Andrew Mackhinal five Shillings to him and his heirs forever —

Item - I give and bequeath to my grand Daughter Mason Vick one Negro namely Jerry to her and her heirs forever —

Item - I give and bequeath to my Grand Son Little Buary Vick one Negro namely Dicky to him and his heirs forever —

Item - I give and bequeath to my grand son John Vick one Negro namely Brooke to him and his heirs forever —

Item - I give and bequeath to my grand Daughter Lucy Vick one Negro namely Peter to her and her heirs forever —

Item - I give and bequeath to my grand son Peterson Vick one Negro namely Venus to him and his heirs forever —

Item - My Will and desire is that all the rest and remainder of my Estate be sold and after my last Debts paid the money arising from such sale to be Equally Divided between my Sons Jacob Vick, Jesse Vick, & John Vick —

I do also constitute and appoint my son Jacob Vick my sole and sole Executor for his my last Will and Testament in Writings whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and affix my seal this 26th day of Sept^r 1798

Further I give her a Riding Chair & Two negroes one Bay Horse, one Bay Mare and Two Feather Beds and Furniture —
