It is my wish and desire, that none of my Estate should be Inventory'd or apprais'd And Lastly I do hereby constitute and Appoint my friend John Rivers Henry Smith Executors of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all other or former Wills or Testaments by me heretofore made, In things aforesaid I have hereunto set my hand and affix'd my seal this 18th day of October 1799 —
