I lend to my wife Mary Adams for her life the use of the plantation whereon I now
live with the half of my Land most convenient to the houses, I also lend her for the
same term the Labour of my slaves Terry Buck & my
I give & bequeath to my daughter Martha Tyler my negroe boy Moses to her &
her heirs
I give and bequeath to my daughter Julia my negroe girl Magh her choice power
I lend to my wife Mary one good work horse three Cows & Calves & Two sows & pigs
also Two beds furniture & such other furniture for the house & Kitchen as my Ex^{rs}
hereafter named may think proper
I hereby direct my Executors hereafter mentioned to sell such of my estate as they
may think proper & pay all my Just debts - The residue of my Estate except
my Land I give may be equally divided between my two daughters Martha
Tyler & Julia
I give and bequeath to my daughter Martha that half of my land which is not
lent unto my wife to her & her heirs
I give and bequeath to my daughter Julia after the death of her mother the
Land & plantation whereon I now live to her & her heirs -
I appoint my son in law Edw^d M. Tyler & My friend Rob^t Goodwyn executors
of this my last will & Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & seal this 7th day of January 1800 -

At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 17th
Day of Feb^r 1800 - This Will was presented in Court by Edw^d
M. Tyler one of the Executors therein named & was by the Courts of Jeremiah
Cobb Sam^l Kells & Robert Coom the Witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded
and on the motion of the s^d Edw^d M. Tyler one of the Executors liberty being reserved
for Rob^t Goodwyn the other executor to qualify hereafter who made oath according
to Law a certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate thereof in due
