branch thence Down the Run of the Spring branch to Lewis Bryants line  
thence a long Lewis Bryant to the Spring branch thence up the Spring  
branch to a white Oak at the Beginning if in Case he should have no heir  
Lawfully begotten of his body to my son Bennett. Now I give  
Now I give my son Bennett Now Bryant the remainder part of my Land also  
one hundred Acres back to him & his heirs forever —  
Now I lend unto my Wife Sarah Bryant all my Land laying in the Fork of the  
Spring branch and the Little branch, beginning at a pine a corner tree in  
Lewis Bryants line thence a straight line to the head of the Spring branch  
thence Down the Spring branch to the Mouth of the Little branch thence up  
the Mouth of the Little branch to a pine in the head of the Little branch  
thence a straight line the Course of the branch to James Bryant line during  
her life, or Widowhood - Likewise I lend her one Negro Girl named Lora  
during her natural Life or Widowhood - Likewise at my Wifes death  
or Marrying the said Negro girl Lora to be Equally Divided between my  
two Daughters Lydia and Pherebah Bryant if either of my Daughters  
should have no heir Lawfully begotten of their body to my son Bennett  
Now Bryant to him & his heirs for ever

Likewise I give my Son Ephraim my Mill to him and his heirs forever —  
Likewise I give my son Bennett the said Mill also the remainder of my Estate  
after paying my Last Debts to be Equal Divided between my Wife & four Children  
I do hereby appoint my Brother Lewis Bryant and my Friend James Magel  
Executors of my Last Will and Testament
