Venus and Child Jemina With the whole of my property after Legacies & debts
are paid of

I likewise constitute and appoint my Friend Kinchin Edwards the whole and
Sole Executor of this my last will and Testament given under my hand and
seal this 22^d Day of January one Thousand Eight hundred
