being sick of body but of sound mind and good memory do make and confirm
this to be my last will and Testament in manner & form following here reciting
and annulling all other Wills heretofore by me made - viz
First I do hereby give of my land to be sold a joining John Pond & John
Mariges Land also adjoining the the road -
Second I also leave one Cow and Two Yearlings to be sold -
Third I also leave Two Sows & Pigs to be sold -
Fourth I also leave Three Sheep to be sold -
Fifth I also leave one Filly to be sold -
These Estates that I above mention is all to be sold for Twelve months
All the Remainder of my Estate I leave to my beloved Wife during her natural
life or Widowhood - After her death or Marriage to be sold to the highest
bidder giving twelve months Credit the money arise from the said sales
Equally divide between all my Children which they are to receive as
they come to the Years of Twenty One -
I desire that Samuel Pond and William Willons and Thomas Wood shall pay
and settle my estate paying my Just debts out of the same -
I nominate and appoint my brother Samuel Pond and William Willons
and Thomas Wood to Executors of this my last will and Testament whereof I have
assent set my hand & seal this Fifteenth day of February 1800

according to Law a Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof
