 Mary Brown one Bed & furniture and the same Painted Chest one box & all  
 & all felly, one Peter basin Two Peter Plates, the Flat Irons & fire-Tongs one Pewter  
 Plate, one writing wheel & boxes two Chairs, the large Singed Table -  
 Item, I give & bequeath to my Grand Son William Turner the Son of Thomas Hart  
 the Negro Man named Jack to him & his heires forever - and I do hereby affir  
 John Hynum Executor of this my last Will and Testament working at first  
 before me made An witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affix  
 my seal this 10<sup>th</sup> Day of June 1799
