After my just debts are paid I give the remainder of my estate of what kind so ever unto my Daughter Eliz^a Stephenson to her and her heirs for ever. I do appoint my loving Wife Nancy Stephenson and my friend Solomon Holmes my whole and sole executors of this my last Will and Testament.
