In The Name of God Amere I George Washington of Kellaway parishes and
 county of Southampton being weak in body but of perfect mind and memory, do
 make and ordain this my Last will and Testament; and do dispose of my estate as follows
 First) I give devise and bequeath unto my son William Washington The plantation
 and all the lands I now own - I give the same to him and his heirs & assigns forever
 Also four negroes Bob and Betty Minge & negro boy ned I say I give the aforesaid negroes
 to my son William and his heirs and assigns forever
 Secondly) I leave the use of my negro boy Tom to my Loving wife Easter Washington
 during her life and after her death I give and bequeath the said negro boy Tom to my
 Son William and his heirs and assigns forever
 Thirdly) I give and bequeath unto my Grandson Henry Johnson Son of Matthew Johnson
 and Sally his wife one negro boy named Dary to him and his heirs forever
 Fourthly) I give and bequeath unto my son William Washington my Soul Home and
 Fifthly) I give and bequeath unto my Loving wife Easter Washington one boy named
 by the name of Joll to her and her heirs forever
