

and the amount awarded amongst my Children equally except my Son to my addition as is before excepted - I also lend unto my Wife all my Beds and bed furniture my Chairs and tables Loom and Harrow thereto belonging three Iron pots one frying pan three Dishes eighteen plates two of my best Horses which I desire she may have as also four of my best Cows and Calves - Two of my best worst Steers - three of my best Sows and their pigs - or sheats - all my Sheep and my stables and appurtenances thereto belonging - It is my will and desire that all my property which I have lent unto my beloved Wife aforesaid during her natural life - shall at her death be sold except my Negro man Roger - and the money arising from the Sale equally divided amongst my Children always excepting my afore said Son Benjamin -

Third I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife fifty Barrells of Corn and as much fodder as is sufficient for the support of the stock I have lent her and after my pork is killed I give unto her one years provision for her self & family out of it

Fourth I give and bequeath unto my Son Benjamin Wood my youngest Colt to him & his heirs forever and as my aforesaid Son Benjamin Wood hath conducted himself in an unauful and improper manner I desire that he shall not enjoy or manage Case property or Inherit any part of my Estate but the Colt I bequeath this day and it is my will that my aforesaid Son Benjamin shall in every case be excluded and disinherited of every other part of my Estate but the bequest of the Colt aforesaid mentioned -

Fifth For the faithful Services and for his fidelity and attachment to me I give my Negro man Roger his freedom at the death of my Wife which I desire he may thereafter enjoy as long as he lives -

Sixth It is my will and desire that all and every part of my property not herein before mentioned shall be sold to the highest bidder in twelve Months Credit and the money arising from the sale after my Just debts and funerals expenses are paid shall be Equally divided amongst my Children Excepting always my Son Benjamin - and I desire that they shall each have there dividend as they arrive at the age of twenty one years -

Seventh I desire that my friends John Hawkins Pond - William Wellons and Thomas Gray shall be guardians to such of my Children as are under age and that my Son shall be bound out at the age of sixteen years to such trade as they may choose and to serve till they are twenty one years of age -

Eighth I nominate and appoint my friends John Hawkins Pond - William Wellons & Thomas Gray to be Executors of this my Last Will and Testament - In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Ninth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and delivered in the presence of
