 County State of virginia being weak in body at present but of sound and perfect
 mind and memory thanks be to almighty god for the same and calling
 to mind the mortality of my body and knowing it is appointed for all to die
 do make and ordain this my last Will and testament Vizt - First of all
 I desire that all my debts and funeral charges be paid and discharged
 I give and bequeath unto my Son Mattew Gardner and his heirs forever the
 plantation wheron he now lives with four hundred acres Land more or less
 one horse which is in his possession

Item Give and bequeath unto my Son Ethelara Gardner and his heirs forever the
 plantation wheron I now live with the rest of virginia lands containing
 four hundred and eighteen acres of land more or less and thirty five bushels
 of Lams out of the tract I left to my Son Mattew I lend to my son
 Ethelara of twelve year one Negroe man Lewis and one horse named Dixie
 and twenty pounds cash

Item Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Daughtry the wife
 of Mattew Daughtry and her heirs forever one Negroe girl named Anna
 That I purchased of David Edmunds & fifteen pounds cash

Item Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Lucrecy Daughtry the wife
 of Theophilus Daughtry and her heirs forever one Negroe girl named Betty

Item Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Milche Webster and her heirs forever
 one Negroe Woman named Selca and twenty five pounds cash called Dixie

Item Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Gardner and her heirs forever
 one Negroe girl named Eddie one horse called Mount one feather bed and
 furniture and six pounds cash
