 County of Southampton in the state of Virginia do make this my Last Will and
 Testament in manner and form following

Imprimis - I give and bequeath to my son Joseph Ruffin all my lands which I
 now live on or may possess at the time of my death also my Negro man
 Charles and Anthony with all my stock of every kind with Crops of corn
 Wheat foder Tobacco Pork & Bacon also all my plantations Utensils
 with all my house hold and kitchen furniture except such as may be here
 in after Excepted I give the above articles to my said son Joseph Ruffin and
 to his heirs forever, and it is my will and desire that he shall not be account
 Table for any former gifts

I give to my Daughter Sarah Tenn Ruffin my Negro woman Charlotte and my
 Negro girls Melly and Easter and their Increase also two feather beds and furniture
 one Chest of Drawers now loaded here one Mahogany Tea Chest all my brand
 Table Spoons one woman's saddle and bridle also all that part of the Debt of
 the United States standing in my name or in the name of my Dec^d Mother
 Lucy Ruffin in the books of the continental Loan office I give the above
 articles to my said Daughter Sarah and her heirs forever; But if my said
 Daughter Sarah should die before she arrives to the age of twenty one years
 or without leaving issue of her body Lawfully begotten then my will is
 that the whole legacy which I have devised to her may revert to my son
