Carolina in hartfort County three hundred and forty three acres more or less known by the deed thereof to him and his heirs forever also I give unto my said Son James Crichtlow the following Negroes Namely one Negro fellow Moses, tract an old fellow and Cyrus a young fellow one Negro wench hammer and her two children Anthony and Sam on Day Stephen one old wench Mann one Negro boy Burwell one Negro boy Sam the above to him and his heirs forever

I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Susanna Cocker the two Negroes fellow she has now already Got Namely Isack and Archer, one Negro Wench Sam and her small Girl Child one Negro wench Maria also all the furniture of different kinds and Stocks also that she has now in her possession to her and her heirs forever

Item

I Give and bequeath unto my Son John Crichtlow my Gray Horse and Sealion and a Mare by the name of Melrow and her Increase also one Negro boy Seaser and half of the stock of Sheep & hogs at both places and three bears and all the furniture he has now in his Possession to him and his heirs forever

Item

I Give and bequeath unto my Son James Crichtlow the Remainder part of my Stock of Different kinds also one Negro wench Grace and the half of my Scur one Pantaloan Colt to him and his heirs forever

Item

My Will and desire is that my Negro Girl patience shall be sold and all my bonds open accounts all of my Estate moveable or unmoveable wheresoever found that is not already Given away after paying my Just Debts to be equally divided between my two Sons James Crichtlow and John Crichtlow to them and their heirs forever

Item

I Give and bequeath unto my Son John Crichtlow the others half of my Scur to him and his heirs forever

I Give and bequeath unto my friend Elizabeth Dunn one bear and furniture to her and her heirs forever
