will and testament in manner following (To Wit) I have this day
any plantation whereon I now live to my loving wife Martha Eun
and during her life or widowhood together with the following slaves
Towels, Pin my, Anna, Dilca, Doll, Levis, Stephen, Tom, Cau & Jeffs also
Cooper & austine also two choice hogs & furniture two choice horses
hund ten head of Choice Cattle all my Sheep half of hogs and half of
all my Crop together with the whole of my household & Kitchen furn
iture plantation utensils and either my speator or single ^{happys} Chair and
one Barrell of Brandy also my Copper still & Cap with all my Hogsheads
& Barrels that hold Cyder - Item I give to my Daughter Susan Edmund
one negro girl Callt Sarah one Sack Satall & Bridle I give to my Son David
W Edmund after the death or Marriage of my wife the plantation
whereon I now live with the household & Kitchen furniture therin contained
legacies Excepted also one negro girl Called fashy - I give unto my son
George W Edmund one acre of Land I purchased of Isaac Johnson &
one negro boy named Jeff and that the balance of my Negroes be held out
until my Daughter Susan marries or arrives to the age of twenty years
and then for that part not otherwise directed to be Divided Equally between
my surviving Children my desire is that Ruth and her two Children Anthony
and India be sold and the money arising from the sale together with the
amount of the other part of my saleable property to be for the use of
Discharging my Debts the balance of my whole estate to be divided between
my Children such as has not bin before given - I appoint my loving
wife Martha Edmund my whole & sole Executrix to this my last will
and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal
