

In the name of God amen I Benjamin Worrell Sen^r of Southampton being Sick and weak in body but of sound disposing mind and memory shew be to god for the same and knowing it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this to be my Last will and testament in manner and form following first I give my Soul to the Almighty god that first gave it unto me and touching what worldly goods I have to Dispose of in manner following —

I give unto my Daughter Patience Taylor five Shillings & Currency to her and her heirs forever —

I give to my Daughter Mitty Barrette five Shillings & Currency to her and her heirs forever —

I give to my Daughter Phiby Newton five Shillings & Currency to her and her heirs forever —

I give and bequeath unto my son Amos Worrell five pounds & money to him and his heirs forever —

I give unto my Daughter Nancy Pope five Shillings & money to her and her heirs forever

I give and bequeath unto my Son Benjamin Worrell one tract of Land Bounded as follows (to wit) beginning at a gum in the String of ponds thence along the String of Ponds to Jacob M^r. Meals line thence along the said M^r. Meals line to a pine corner tree from thence to Richard Williams line to a pine thence along the said Williams line to a turkey Oak standing in the said Worrells line from thence to the beginning the same being part of the tract of Land where on I now live to him and his heirs forever —

I give and bequeath unto my son James Worrell to him and his heirs forever all the Residence of my Land not heretofore given away it being the old plantation where on I now live Estimated at two hundred and thirty five acres to take possession of the said Land and plantation after the Death of my Beloved wife —

I lend to my Beloved wife Mary Worrell the use of my plantation above disposed of, to my Son James Worrell during her life also all the Residence of my personal estate and after the death of my wife I give the D^r personal property to my daughter Polly Pope. I had a negro by the name of David to my wife (Mary Worrell) and after the death of my wife I give the D^r negro David to my daughter Polly Pope to live and her heirs forever —

I do hereby appoint my wife Mary Worrell & James Worrell whole & Sole Executors of this my last will & testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twelfth of April one thousand
