all once to die - do make and ordain this my last will and Testament that is to say
principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul into the hands of almighty God
that gave it and my Body I recommend to the earth to be Buried in a Christian like
form at the discretion of my Executors; And Touching such estate that it hath
pleased god to bless me with in this life - I give devise and Bequeath & dispose
of the Same in the following manner -
I give Devise & Bequeath to my son John Drewry my plantation & lands thereunto
Belonging containing by Estimation one hundred & Seventy five Acres to him
and his heirs forever -
I give devise & Bequeath to my Son Lewis Drewry the plantation & lands thereunto
