I Jesse Gardner Sen^r of Southampton County Virginia being Sen Good hearted and of Sound mind and memory, best calling to mind the mortality of my body do make and ordain this my Last will & testament in manner and form following to wit
Suprims- I leave to my Loving Wife Elizabeth Gardner the full use of my land and plantations during her life- I also leave the three Negroes to wit two Boys Aaron & Amos & Girl Asia during her life
Item- I give to my Son Joshua Gardner five Shilling cash
Item- I give to my Daughter Sally Gardner one Negro Girl Leticia to her and her heirs forever
I give to my Son John Gardner five Shillings cash and one Negro Boy Alexander to him and his heirs forever
I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Gardner five shilling cash
All the residue of my estate of my kind Whatsoever after my Debts are paid I leave the use thereof to my wife during her life-
