Item — I give to my son John Gardner five Shillings cash and one Negro Boy Alexander to him and his heirs forever

Item — I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Gardner five shilling cash

All the residue of my estate of my land Whatesoever after my debts are paid I leave the use thereof to my wife during her life —
