In the Name of Good Amur, I John Moore of the County of Southampton
and Parish of Saint Luke do make and declare this my last will and testament as follows to wit -
I give to my living wife Temperance above the plantation wherein I now live, also the use of all my slaves,
stock of all kinds whatsoever Household and Kitchen Furniture, Plantation Utensils, my whole crop of all kinds
whatever, to her during her natural life. And further my wife's desire is for my children to be sole
entitled to my estate and each of my sons to be bound out when they arrive to the age of Fifteen years, and
my daughters to live with my wife until they come of age or marry and to be supported out
of my Estate -

I give and bequeath to my son Henry Moore the Plantation wherein I now live after the death of
my wife to him and his heirs forever -

I give and bequeath my lands lying in Carolina unto my sons Thomas Moore and James Moore & his
that is to be equally divided Between them to them and their heirs forever -

I give and bequeath to my daughter Rebekah Moore the Negro Girl named Dorcas &
her increase after the death of my wife to her and her heirs forever -

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sally Moore the Negro girl named Nancy and her increase
after the death of my wife to her and her heirs forever -

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Catharine Moore the negro girl named Mason her increase
after the death of my wife to her and her heirs forever -

I give and bequeath unto my child which my wife is now pregnant with one Negro Boy
named Isham, after the death of my wife to her and her heirs forever -

My further wish and desire is after the death of my wife for my Whole Estate that is not already
given away to be sold by my executors and the Money to be equally divided between the whole of my
children and their heirs forever -

and further I do appoint my friends Bay & Blunt and Henry Blunt my whole and sole Executors to
this my last will and testament - Witness whereof I have hereunto set and affixed my hand and
seal this 15 day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and one
