

I do give & bequeath to my son Thomas Warner three Negroes - namely
 Pelt Jim, since Sarah gave him and his heirs forever -
 I do give & bequeath to my two Grandsons namely Joseph & James
 Warner Sons of Amos Warner when they shall come of lawful
 age Twenty one pounds each of them to be paid by my said son
 Warner to them and their heirs forever - But provided before either
 of my Grand Sons should be of lawful age it is my
 Will and desire that that estate which I have left them in their
 will may be equally divided between those three Sisters namely
 Lucy and Nancy R. Warner -

It is my Will and desire at my death that my land & plantation
 together with my Stock of horses & Stock of all kinds Crops household
 & kitchen Furniture Plantations Attendants with all the issues of
 my estate which I have not given away in this my will may be
 equally divided between my two Sons namely Thomas & Noah
 Warner, and that my said two Sons for the benefit of the above estate
 shall furnish my Daughter Sarah Jordan with a house to live in
 during her Widowhood & that my said son Noah Warner out of
 his part of estate left him pay to my two grandsons the legacy left
 them in this my Will -

I do constitute & appoint my two sons Noah & Thomas Warner
 whole & sole Executors of this my last will and testament working
 and discharging all wills heretofore by me made discharging this
 the only to be my last Will and testament In Witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this 23rd
 day of February 1803

At a court held for the county of St. James the
 10th day of May 1806 The will was proved by
 the oaths of Wm Chambers & Robt Weylke & Robt

Wastey the witnesses thereto and continued for ex^{am} and account held
 for that said county 18th July 1803 This will having been before
 proved by the wit. and continued for ex^{am} whereupon Noah Warner
 who was named Ex^{or} in & will appeared and gave loud & qualified
 according to law; and on the motion of Ex^{or} who made oath
 according to law, certificate was granted him for obtaining
 a probate thereof in due form requiring security whereupon &c
