body, but of perfect sense and memory, declare and ordain this to be
my last will and Testament in the manner and form as follows (W.D.)

Item

I give and bequeath unto my Son John Wright all my land and
plantation where on I now live containing by estimation one hundred
Acres be the same more or less together with one feather bed & furniture
also all the stock of what kind soever that may be on the said plantation
at my death to him and his heirs forever -

I give and bequeath unto my Son John Wright twenty shillings
cash to be his portion of all my whole Estate to him and his heirs
forever - -

Item

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Crumpler twenty
shillings to be her portion of all my whole Estate to her & her heirs forever

Item

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Rhoda Blythe twenty
shillings to be her portion of all my whole Estate to her & her heirs forever

Item

I give and bequeath unto my son Benjⁿ Wright twenty shillings
to be his portion of all my whole Estate to him and his heirs forever

Item

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Eliz^a Crumpler one feather bed
and furniture to her and her heirs forever -

I give and bequeath unto my son Benjⁿ Wright twenty shillings to
be his portion of all my whole Estate to him and his heirs forever -

Item

I give and bequeath unto my son John Wright the residue of my whole
Estate not above mentioned of what kind or kind soever to him
and his heirs forever, and lastly I do appoint my son John Wright
& John Crumpler j^r to be my whole and sole executor of this my last
will and Testament Discharging and making void all other wills
hereto forborne, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this 12th day of January 1803
