my sons Henry, B. Vaughan and George Vaughan -

My will and desire is that the money & Job. I now have by
me be appropriated to the discharge of my Debts, And for the ex-
ecution of this my last Will and Testament I Appoint my
Cham^r. Vaughan and Humphrey Executors - In witness
whereof I have unto set my hand this 10th day of April 1803
