 there in Name - proved by the oaths of Wm. J. and David
 Thomas the witnesses thereto since deceased to be recorded - and on the
 Motion of the Said Executor Whennan according to law, probat
 was granted him as giving bond &c -

In the Name of God Amen - I Laurence Williams of
 Southampton County and State of Virginia being of Perfect mind and memory
 (blessed be God) do this 9th day of March in the year of our Lord 1803
 make and declare this my last will and Testament as follows

I give unto my Sister Pippilla Carr wife of Arthur Carr Severely &c
 Acres of Land adjoining the said Arthur Carr beginning at a pine in
 the said Carrs line thence near a Southeast course to a post oak, thence
 up the Stream to make the said Seventy five Acres to her and her heirs
 forever, provided they the said Pippilla and Arthur Carr pay unto my brother
 Daniel Williams and David Williams one hundred and twenty
 five dollars each but if the said Pippilla Carr and Arthur Carr (her
 husband) do not pay unto my brother Daniel Williams and David Williams
 one hundred and twenty five dollars each then my assent is that the said
 Land should be equally divided between the said Pippilla Carr (wife of
 Arthur Carr) Daniel Williams to them and their heirs forever

I give all the remainder of my Land in Southampton County State of Virginia to my
 Sisters Polly Williams Sonny Williams & my brother Matthew Williams who
 equally divide between them at their discretion to them and their heirs forever
 I give all the remainder of my property (be it of what kind or nature whatsoever
 after paying my just debts) likewise to my Sisters Polly & Sonny Williams
 and my brother Matthew Williams to them and their heirs forever

I do hereby appoint my trusty friends Daniel Williams (my brother) and
 Arthur Carr my whole and Sole Executors of this my last will and Testa-
 ment - working all other wills before made ratifying this as my last
 and to be my last will and Testament in witness whereof I the said Laurence
 Williams have hereunto set my hand and seal the day & year first
