

45 In the name of God Amen, I Benj. Blunt of S^t.ampton County being of
 sound mind and disposing memory do make and declare this my last Will & Testament
 in manner and form as followeth (Vizd)
 I give unto my ^{dear} daughter Ann Peto, one Negro man named Sam. to her &
 his heirs -
 I give unto my grandson Benj. William Blunt one Negro man named Billy to
 him and his heirs -
 I give unto my son Rich^d. Blunt the sum of two hundred dollars, together
 with all negroes stock of all kinds, plantation utensils household furniture,
 &c. &c. which I have already delivered to him and received in his possession,
 all which I give unto him and his heirs -
 I give unto my son Benj. Blunt, the tract of land that I purchased
 of Micajah Peto, containing one hundred and fifty Acres, and the tract
 of land that I purchased of H. & M. Vaughan, containing two hundred
 and eighty Acres, and the tract of land that I purchased of Elisha Knott
 containing one hundred & one Acre, and also the tract of land that I
 purchased of Moses Johnson, containing twenty three Acres, and at his death
 I give unto him the tract of land whereon Snow lives containing
 four hundred and thirty seven Acres, I also give unto him eleven Negroes namely
 Cepid, Hounds, Suckey, Henry, Jack, Epse, Dicey, Beckey, Sam, and Fanny
 and 8 Amos, to go with the Increase from the said land of, all which I give
 unto my s^{on} Benj. and to his heirs forever, I also give unto my s^{on} Benj.
 my Bedford young mare, and my gold Watch -
 I leave unto my beloved wife Francis Blunt, during her natural life, three
 of the land and plantation whereon Snow lives containing four hundred
 and thirty seven Acres, and the tract of land that I purchased of Howell
 Edwards containing 800 Acres also the following Negroes, namely
 Dabo, Ned, ~~also~~ Pat Ephraim, Dick, Shaiput, Sarah Nancy, Melly, Phillis,
 Milly, Phogaw, George, Gaster, Rose, Titus, David, Mary, Sam, Gester,
 Ann, Mariah, Cecilia, Floullas, and Dolley, together with their increase
 from the date here of, and also all the Remainder of my stock of Horses
 Shays and Stags, all my house hold and Kitchen furniture to go with
 the whole of the Remainder of my estate, and I for hereby give and give
 unto my s^{on} Benj. Francis full power to dispose of all and every part of
 the personal Estate hereby lent to her (Slaves excepted) in any manner
 that she think proper, but upon the condition that she ~~shall~~ give her
 gifts, or loans, amongst my Children or grand children or their descendants
 I wish that this legacy may be considered as a loan of good, as to her self
 wife her self and every other Right, title & Interest, that she may claim,
 have or demand in any manner in any manner whatsoever of my
 estate of any part or parcel thereof -
 I give in condition to the ~~above~~ Legacy before mentioned unto my son Rich^d. Blunt one
 Negro boy named Peter to him and his heirs -
 I give unto my daughter Ann Peto, and unto unto my grand son Benj. Blunt all that
 tract of land that I purchased of Howell Edwards, to be divided between them at
 my wife's death in the following manner (Vizd) beginning on the white cedar branch
 4 paces below the upper end of S^{on}net's trees line in the s^{on} Benj. Blunt's
 line across the land unto the pole branch, so as to divide the s^{on} Benj. Blunt's
 Lots of equal number of Acres, that part of the lying below the line to the
 Peto's line to his heirs
