 this to be my last will and testament after recommending my soul

 of in form and manner following.

I give and bequeath unto William Foster Sampson Foster my
 Small tract of Land on the Southside of the three Creeks adjoining Thomas
 Ridley and Arthur Turner to him and his heirs forever

I lend unto Elizabeth Clanton the use of my Land and plantation where
 - on I now live all my Negroes namely, Jack the Elder, Jack Thorp Cyrus
 Sanny Mimma Shrey, Charlotte, Patrick Selvy Edes Fanny & Willy
 my Stocks of all kinds household and kitchen furniture &c
 - ther with all the residue of my Estate of what ever nature
 or kind it may consist of after paying all my Just debts
 until the said Elizabeth Clanton has another Child or until
 Polly Foster Clanton should be Married, in either of those
 Cases or when either shall take place the said Elizabeth Clanton
