 will & Testament in manner & form following that is to say
 I give to my son Arthur Williamson my land and plantations in
 Sussex County that I purchased of Benj^d Murrable, also one young
 sorrel horse named Cicero and one saddle and bridle to him
 and his heirs forever
 I give to my wife Martha Williamson the land & plantations wherein
 I now live during life or widowhood and after her death or
 marriage I give the aforesaid land and plantations to my son Thomas
 Williamson also one young pig named Lilly and one saddle and
 bridle to him and his heirs forever
 I give to my Daughter Sally Williamson two negroes namely
 Rebecca and Dolly and their increase to her and her heirs
 forever
 I give to my son Andrew Williamson two negroes namely
 Anne and Peter to him and his heirs forever
 I give to my daughter Polly Williamson two negroes namely
 Hannah and Amy and their increase to her and her heirs forever
 I give to my son Sattetore Williamson two negroes namely
 Cychariah & Amos to him and his heirs forever
 I give to my daughter Patsy Williamson two negroes namely
 Edmund and William and their increase to her and her heirs forever
 I give to my son Benj^d Williamson two negroes namely
 Henry and one and their increase to him & his heirs forever
 My will and desire is that all the negroes that I have given to my
 children named above, should be kept or continued in possession
 of my wife or she may live out as many of the aforesaid negroes
 as she may think proper until my son or children hereinafter
 named should arrive to the age of twenty one years or should be
 married and if either of the above mentioned negroes should die
 before either of my children to whom they are given, shall arrive
 to the age of twenty one years or married I desire that my Estate
 should make good the value thereof —
