 money do make and Ordain this my last will and Testament in the manner and form
 as followeth (Wth)

I Give the use of the plantation whereon I now live with the real and Personal estate
 Therein except the Slave and negro woman Sylvia to my loving wife Sally Kindred
 during her natural life or so long as she shall live, at her death, I desire that the whole
 of the estate that I lend to her except the land, to be sold at the discretion of my
 Executors and to be equally divided between all my Children except my son
 Alonzo Kindred namely Martha Moller Alonzo Kindred, Sarah, Mary Margaret,
 Henry, Sarah, and Elizabeth Kindred —

I Give and bequeath unto my Son Alonzo Kindred at the death or marriage of my
 wife Sally Kindred the land that I lent her to him and his heirs forever —

I desire is that my land lying on the flat Swamp, that I bought of Saml. Thompson
 to be sold with my Slave and negro woman Sylvia, at the discretion of my
 executors, and after my just debts are paid the money arising from such sales
 to be equally divided between my Children above named, except my daughter
 (Kindred) or they shall arrive to the age of twenty one years —

I desire that my estate may not be Appraised — I do Appoint my friends
 Ethel. Coomer and Rich^d. Blunt Junr. Executors of this my last will and
 Testament by me made In Witness Whereof I have hereunto Set my hand
 and Affixed my Seal this 4th day of March eighteen hundred and four —
