 to make and a dam the my last will and testament in manner and form following

I bequeath my Soul to Almighty God who gave it me and body to the earth
 to be buried in a Christian like manner trusting in a glorious resurrection
 thro' the merits of my dear Redeemer Jesus Christ.

I give and bequeath to my brother and Sisters (Wife) James Boone, David
 Boone, Susannah Heathorn and Rebecca Boone all my Land to equally give
 and between them, to them and their heirs to have and to hold forever.

I shew my will and desire that my negro man Abram should have his freedom
 and enjoy it and desire is that if either of the above Legatees or all interrupts
 the said negro man Abram in his freed om that he or they shall have nothing of
 the above legacies but that it shall fall to the Commonwealth.

I give and bequeath to Elizabeth Landrum our teacher his wife and her heirs to have and to hold
 forever.

My desire is that all my just debts shall be paid and the balance of Estate
 be equally divided amongst my above named brother and Sister.

I do constitute and appoint to this my last will and testament Wmth Whitefield
 and my brother James Boone my executors give under my hand and seal this 2^d day
 of February 1804.
