

In the of God Amos, I Luke Archer of the County of Hampshire
 my last will and testament in the manner and form following (viz) -

I Give unto my beloved wife Hannah Archer my land Spurches Ed. of Arthur
 Whitehead, containing by Estimation, Ten and Half Acres more or less and bound
 by the well known lines, during her natural life or widowed also I Give unto
 my said wife during her natural life over and above her first choice of one
 Cow and Calf, one Sow and Pigs, four Sheep and also all my House hold &
 Kitchen Furniture Plantation Utensils and Eleven Geese -

I Give and bequeath unto my said wife five hundred pounds Next, Part
 and fifteen Barrells Corn also a sufficiency of Hodges for his Stock one
 year - And my will and desire is that that after the death or Marriage
 of my said wife, the Land and Personal Estate, I have lent her should be
 Sold, and the money arising from such Sale should be Equally divided
 between my three child ren, Samuel, Ely, Vynus, Reuben Betsy and
 Betsey Archers to them and their Heirs forever, also my will is at my
 death that all my Estate that I have not lent nor given away should
 be sold, and the money arising from such Sale, should be Applied to
 the Maintenance of my three youngest child ren Namely, Betsy
 Betsy and Betsey Archers and my will and desire is that my wife
 should keep my two youngest boys, Betsy and Betsey, untill they arriv
 to the age of twelve years, after that time to be put out to good Creditable
 places as she sees proper, also I Give for my said wife to keep my two girls
 Vynus and Betsy untill they are free by the laws of my Country, also
 I do Appoint my trusty friends Reuben Hancock and Matt Whitehead
 as Masters for the other three children, Samuel, Ely, and Reuben to
 Serve their said Masters untill they arrive to the age of twenty one -

And I do Appoint my beloved wife Hannah Archer my whole sole
 executrix of this my last will and testament - Utterly revoking and
 disallowing all and every other will, legacy Testament, or bequest what
 ever before mentioned - In witness whereof I have hereunto set
 my hand and Affixed my seal this 22nd day of November 1802
