Acres more or less, to him and his heirs forever —

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Fanny Bracey two my Shillings
to her and her heirs forever —

Item I give and bequeath unto my grand son Elias Bracey one hundred and fifty pounds
Cash and after the marriage or death of my said wife my negro boy Cham my negro
girl Peggy and one feather bed and furniture to him and his heirs forever

Item I give unto my said wife during her natural life or in default all the remainder
of my estate of what nature or Quality soever, and after the marriage death
of my said wife, I give and bequeath unto my Son Richard Edwards my negro
boy Jacob and my negro girl Lucy; unto my son Eley my negro boy
Martin my negro girl Cherry, my negro boy Fred, and twenty six pounds Cash
unto my son Lewis Edwards my negro boy Sam my part of a negro man
Pompy my shute and and my negro Joney to them and their heirs forever
And all the remainder of my estate at the last mentioned time to be equally
divided between my three Son and grand Sons (Viz) Richard, Eley, Sam
and Elias Bracey — Lastly I appoint my beloved wife Eliz^a Edwards
and my Son Richard Edwards Esq. and Co^s to this my last will and testament
