Item I give and bequeath unto my son Lewis Edwards my negro girl Cherry  
and her increase, and after the marriage or Death of my beloved wife the  
lives and Plantation wherein I now live Containing two hundred and fifty  
Acres more or less, to him and his heirs forever —

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Fanny Bracey the entire Slaves  
to her and her heirs forever —

Item I give and bequeath unto my grandson Elias Bracey one hundred and fifty acres  
Bush and after the marriage or Death of my said wife my negro boy John my negro  
girl Piggy and one feather bed and furniture to him and his heirs forever

Item unto my said wife during her natural life or in whose all the remainder  
of my estate of what nature or Quality soever, and after the marriage or Death  
of my said wife, I give and bequeath unto my Son Kinchin Edwards my negro  
boy Jacob and my negro girl Lucy unto my son Ebey my negro boy  
Martin my negro girl Cherry my negro boy and also twenty six pounds cash  
unto my son Lewis Edwards my negro boy Sam my part of a negro man  
Pompy my slave and my negro Joney to them and their heirs forever —  
And all the remainder of my estate at the last mentioned period to be equally  
Divided between my three Son and grand Sons (viz) Kinchin, Ebey, Lucy  
and Elias Bracey — Lastly I appoint my beloved wife Eliz. Edwards  
and my son Kinchin Edwards sole and sole to this my last will and testament  
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my
