

6th I give and bequeath to my son William Blaw, part of the land I bought
of Thomas Sarrub (decd. viz) also that lies between Popes branch, (which
is now called the Chordhouse Swamp) and Truckworths to Swampen
made by the names of the old Quaker and Shoelhouse plantations also
I give to my said son William Blaw fifty four Acres land, it being the
land, where Benjamin Edwards and formerly lived the husband
whereof was a person by referring to the report in Chancery which is recorded in
the County Court of Sampson, also the following negroes (to wit) Isaac
Sam, Cliffee, Will, Moses, Nat. Bradd. Mary my Great, Lucy Martha and
Anna, with their future increase, also the Shelalah mare, twenty head of
Cattle and six head of Sheep to be allotted of to him by my will also
the hogs he now claims, and which are marked different from my other hogs
also the house hold and kitchen furniture plantation utensils of every kind and
every and every other kind of Property now in his possession (except one feather
bed and furniture which I lent him) also one large Copper Kettle to him
and his heirs forever —

7th I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary Briggs Cricklow the
following negroes, namely, Lemm, Aaron, little Bob, Patty, Annier, and
her child Patty, Annier, Nanny, Molly, and Nelson with their future increase
also one feather bed and furniture and one chest of drawers to her and her heirs
forever —

8th I give and bequeath to my son John Thomas Blaw the tract of land which is
now live except a meadow of trees wherein thereon which he gives to my son Henry
Blaw being the land which lies between Popes Branch, (now called the Chordhouse
Swamp) and Thomas's branch, bounded by the corner of E. D. branch the
Vaughan Jordan Underwood, John Underwood, lines with the plantation
Hoxes and still thereon; also the following negroes, namely, Quatam,
Darius, Jack, little Tom, Dae, Bruns with, Ephraim, Eleck, Bot,
Yellow, Lucy, and Hannah, Daughter of Bot, with their future increase
also the Sampson Man, the Brindley, Cilt and the Shipson house
also, twenty head of Cattle and six head of sheep, which are to be allotted
to him and his heirs forever —
