

That remains after my occasional have as told of my Tools for the purchase of Land & my my Debt & I should Appear refuge any as mentioned in the second Section of this writing. Also one half my Cyber Barnes one half my Prop on hand, one half of my plantation Wet sils, the feather bed and Remains, besides the one he has now in his possession, one old Desk See leather bottomed Chair, one large Walnut table, one pine Chest, one painted Cupboard, and my part of Paul the black Smith and his tools to him and his him forever —

17th May I give to my son George Blau the Sum of one hundred and thirty dollars, Annually, during his natural life which sum is to be paid to him (yearly) by my son Henry Blau his heir etc or adm^r in consideration of the estate which is hereafter given my son Henry—

I give to my son Henry Blaw all that part of my land which lies on the west side of the
 main mile Swamp, and East side of Thomas's branch known by the name of the edge
 and Margaret Davis's & sister with all the land which lies between Dutch and
 Shute's Swamp, Louisa branch, and Henry Thomas line (except the land
 given land more or less before given to my son Rich^d, known by the name of Blaw
 with my water house mill and all her appurtenances of every kind, also all that tract or
 Parcel of land which I purchased of the trustees of the Nottoway tribe of
 Indians on which appears by a deed recorded in County Court of S. Car. containing
 seven hundred and thirty four acres. Also the survey of trees on the land given
 to my son John, and which is excepted in the devise to him) Also the following
 Negroes (to wit) old Peter, Bob, Bin, Isham, Ann her land, old Lucy, by law, and
 also her children (Vizt) Amy, Nancy, and Hank, also Phineas, son (Vizt) little Mary,
 Mrs. Archer, little Sam, Sepia, old Sam, Clay, young Jimmy and Winne and
 their future Increase, also the young bay Colt, the buckskin mare, and the two
 Mules twenty head of Cattle, and six head of Sheep, (exclusive of those on the
 Plantation, which I bought of the Indian Trustees to be allotted off by my
 and one half of my Shute Shute, and Pigeon besides those on the last above
 mentioned plantation, that remaining after my wife's share is divided often
 to raise money to pay my debts one half my crop on hand one half my
 plantation utensils, all my plow and scantling on hand, one half my
 Barrels, also two feather beds, and furniture, my best desk, one small iron
 stove one Walnut Cupboard four leather bound Chairs and all the stock of
 every kind the house hold and kitchen furniture plantation utensils one third
