Harris will and Publish this as my Last will and Testament in manner and form following

1st I give to my beloved wife Lucy Harris the use of the land and Plantation in
an Area here containing by Estimation two hundred and Seventy five Acre or
else from my other by as less of marked trees from Lucy William Littie & him
bank, during my said wife's natural life also less to my said wife the
use of the following Slaves during her life to wit New Littie, Rose
Tim Ally and Millie. Also less to my said wife ten of my Cattle such as
she may choose of I also less my said during her life her choice of two
horses as well as the choice of twenty Hogs and the use of three feather bed
and furniture and also the use of a Copper Still with its Appertenances
and also the use of all my House hold and Kitchen furniture plantation
itter with ~~to except~~ Such part as is hereafter given away all of which
property I wish my said wife peacefully and quietly to possess and enjoy during
her natural life.

2nd I give and bequeath to my son Eum Harris the other part of tract of Land named
as mentioned above containing by Estimation two hundred and twenty five
Acres to him and to his heirs forever, I except the priodage of my daughter Sally
living in the dwelling House with him and my said son Eum Harris during her
living Single I also give to my said ~~Sister~~ Eum one negro boy named
the man, Cattle his own son and pigs one feather bed and furniture all of
which is now in his possession, all of which I give to my said son and to his heirs
forever.

3rd I give and bequeath to my daughter Nancy Brantley one negro girl named
Chinie one mares and one feather bed & furniture all of which are now
in her possession, all of which I give to my said daughter and to
her heirs forever, I also give to my said daughter twenty five pounds
of Cash after the death of my wife.

4th I give and bequeath to my two grand Children two negroes now in the
possession of my daughter Nancy (that is) Millie and Littie who
I desire may be equally divided between my two grand Children

Eliza & Sally Brantley to them and their heirs forever.
