

I Hannan James of Hampton being of sound mind and memory do hereby to pre-  
 sent dispute about a division of the Estate that I may leave at my death do make certain  
 and Publish this as my Last will and Testament in manner and form following

1<sup>st</sup> I Give to my beloved wife Lucy Harris the use of the land and Plantations  
 now hereafter containing by Estimation two hundred and Seventy five Acres  
 and from my other by a line of marked trees from Lucy Williams line to the  
 hand, during my said wife's natural life I also lend to my said wife the  
 use of the following Slaves during her life to wit Nelson Little, Bree  
 Jim Ally and Willey. I also lend to my said wife ten of my Cattle Such as  
 She may Choose of I also lend my said during her life her choice of two  
 horses as well as the choice of twenty Hogs and the use of three feather beds  
 and furniture and also the use of a Copper Stove with its Appurtenances  
 and also the use of all my House hold and Kitchen Furniture Plantation  
 Utensils except such part as is hereafter given away all of which  
 property I wish my said wife peacefully and quietly to possess and enjoy during  
 her natural life =

2<sup>nd</sup> I Give and bequeath to my son Eum Harris the other part of Tract of Land aforesaid  
 as mentioned above containing by Estimation two hundred and twenty five  
 Acres to him and to his heirs forever, I except the privilege of my daughter Sally  
 living in the dwelling House with him my said son Eum Harris during her  
 living Single I also give to my said son Eum one negro boy named  
 two mare Cattle his own sow and pigs one feather bed and furniture all of  
 which is now in possession, all of which I give to my said son and to his heirs  
 forever

3<sup>rd</sup> I Give and bequeath to my daughter Nancy Brantley one negro girl named  
 Chimie one mare and one feather bed and furniture all of which are now  
 in her possession, all of which I give to my said daughter and to  
 her heirs forever. I also give to my said daughter twenty five pounds  
 of Cash after the death of my wife =

4<sup>th</sup> I Give and bequeath to my two grand Children two negroes now in the  
 possession of my daughter Nancy (that is) Miller and Lettie whom  
 I wish may be equally divided between my two grand Children  
 I Give & Sally Brantley to them and their heirs forever
